## 1 COGNITION & LEARNING

A Cognition and Learning training offer delivered by Educational Psychologists exploring practical strategies.

## 2 INCLUSIVE SCHOOLS

There is Educational Psychology attendance at Secondary TAS meetings, as well as regular input into the Inclusion Network Meetings.

## 3 TEEN LIFE

A 6 week training programme for parents of young people aged 10-16 with a diagnosis of autism. School staff can also attend to support parents/carers and develop their own knowledge..

## 4 SOLUTION CIRCLES

A training offer delivered by Educational Psychologists and Assistant Educational Psychologists at either whole school or smaller group level , exploring practical problem solving strategies.

## Social Emotional Mental Health (SEMH)

**01** ADVICE AND SUPPORT  
ALLOCATION PANEL (ASAP)  
AND LOCALITY INCLUSION  
PANEL (LIP) SEMH WORK

Educational Psychologists work into the ASAP and LIP Panel and support work around young people with specific SEMH needs. This often takes the form of consultation and strategic support.

**02** SITUATIONAL  
MUTISM

A new training offer for schools exploring how to support young people experiencing Situational Mutism (SM).

**03** SEMH SCHOOL  
EFFECTIVENESS  
TEAM

Activity supporting the work of the new SEMH team. Focusing on a training offer and support to the teachers and Inclusion Support Worker in that team.

SEMH TRAINING  
TEAM **04**

A training and support offer for selected secondary schools utilising the SRs model. This project is supported by colleagues across a range of services.

EMOTIONALLY  
BASED SCHOOL  
NON-ATTENDANCE **05**

A training offer to schools and services on Emotionally Based School Non-Attendance (EBSNA).





**① COGNITION AND LEARNING OFFER**

Educational Psychologists provide individual casework support through the LIP/ASAP.

**② EARLY YEARS INITIATIVES**

Educational Psychologists will deliver training and development work alongside the SENDOS Early Years Team.

**KALEIDRASCOPE ③**

Supporting young people and their families who are International New Arrivals through educational psychology assessment, intervention and school training.

**CRITICAL INCIDENTS ④**

Educational Psychologists will offer direct support into schools following on from Critical Incidents.. The Educational Psychology Service is also developing resources for school use.

**ADDITIONALLY RESOURCED PROVISIONS / SPECIAL SCHOOLS ⑤**

All ARPs and Special Schools receive support and training from the Educational Psychology Service.

## VIRTUAL SCHOOL

Educational Psychologists provide input into the Virtual School, offering support, guidance and assessment for Looked After Children.

## YOUTH JUSTICE SERVICE (YJS)

Educational Psychologists work into the Youth Justice Service providing training and support around individuals.

The Developmental Language Disorder (DLD) Team receive consultancy support from Educational Psychologists.

## SENSORY TEAMS

Educational Psychologists work into the Hearing Impairment (HI) and Visual Impairment (VI) Team., by offering training and support around individuals.

Training and support is offered by the Educational Psychology Service to staff within Children's Homes, alongside individual casework.
