

Newcastle City Learning Free Courses for Jobs

What is the initiative?

In September 2020 the government announced Free Courses for Jobs, a new initiative set up to help those who have not achieved a Level 3 progress in their education through free training.

Who is it for?

This opportunity is for anyone who is aged 19 or over (on or after 31st August 2022) and does not already have a level 3 qualification or higher. You might also be eligible even if you have a level 3 qualification or higher but are on a low wage. You can contact us for more information about eligibility.

How does it work?

You will attend college and be supported by a tutor in your usual place of work and with online tutorials. You'll complete work that has been set by your tutor and build a portfolio of evidence leading to certification of your chosen qualification.

What are the benefits?

Unlike an apprenticeship, there'll be no need to achieve English and maths at level 2 before the end of the programme and you won't need to complete off-the-job training! We can still support you to achieve English and maths, but you can decide when and if you'd like to do it.

Level 3 Certificate in Health and Social Care (15 months)

Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Workforce (Early Years Educator) (18 months)
